- A. Name change and new way of thinking. V.4&7
- B. To question their purpose.
- C. To cause them to wonder why they were there.
 - 2. Their integrity was being threatened. V.8
- A. Not wanting to defile their bodies. Lev. 17:10
- B. They wanted to stay clean before God.
- C. Their spiritual values were being tested. Act. 5:29
 - 3. Their influence was being a testimony. V. 9&10
- A. Their faith grows as they see God's hand on them. V 9 & 15
- B. They looked different than the others. V 15
- C. That God gave knowledge and insight. V 17

Application for us today.

- 1. It's easy to go along with the group but that doesn't make it right.
- 2. It's important to have a good support group. Prov. 27: 17
- 3. Being different is not a bad thing. 1Pe.2:9
- 4. Knowing who you are is most important. Gal. 2:20
