- 3. Jesus shows humility in His suffering. Mk.15:15-20
 - A. He is beaten as a criminal.
 - B. He is mocked and made fun of .

- 4. Jesus shows mercy on the cross. Lk. 23:43 Heb. 13:12
 - A. The sinner was forgiven.

Application for us today.

- 1. Our accuser is Satan & the cross takes care of him. It's not us but Christ that defeats the enemy.
- 2. Sin has a way of multiplying itself. Once it starts it looks at all sin as it's not wrong.
