 - A. They felt let down. V. 20-24
 - B. They talked as being sad and reasoning why this happened. V17c
 - C. Possibly just wanted to get away from everyone.
- 2. Notice Jesus drew near to them. V .15
 - A. He was concerned about their sadness, V. 17
 - B. He wanted to hear from them. V.18&19
 - C. They don't realize it is Jesus. V. 16
- 3. Notice Jesus drew them to the scripture. V .27
 - A. He starts with Moses. (Serpent in the wilderness) Jn. 3:14&15
 - B. His ministry was a fulfillment of the Old Testament.
 - C. The scriptures caused them to be attentive. V. 29
- 4. Notice Jesus drew them to the table. V. 30&31
 - A. He took time to fellowship with them. V 28
 - B. His Word & fellowship caused them to see. V 31&32
 - C. Their heart was burning for more and needed to share it. V.33

Application for us today.

- 1. Jesus is pursuing us on our walk. Jn. 6:44
- 2. When we are in desperation, we're not to run away.
- 3. We will be let down by man but not by the Lord.
- 4. Our walk with Jesus is a daily exercise.
- 5. Our study of the scripture includes all the Bible.
- 6. Our fellowship with Him causes us to see differently.
- 7. Our witness for Christ needs passion. V 32&35, 45-49 & 53
